- Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by J. Peck.
- II. Public Comments: None
- III. Prior Meeting Minutes: The draft minutes from the last PC meeting were circulated and no comments were received. A motion was made by R. Hagemann to accept the prior (11/17/20) meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by K. Mix and passed unanimously.
- IV. Brownville Bridge Replacement Presentation: A presentation was made by Kent Collier on the proposed work for the Brownville Bridge Replacement Project. Kent is the NYSDOT Job Manager for the project.
- V. Resolution #2 2021 TIP Amendment: A motion was made by K. Mix to approve Resolution #2-2021 which amends the current TIP to increase the funding for PIN 775362 (Court/Massey/Coffeen Street Project). It was seconded by S. Docteur and passed unanimously. See Appendix A for the full text of the resolution.
- VI. Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP): The draft UPWP has been prepared. A motion was made by K. Mix to release the UPWP for public comment. It was seconded by R. Hagemann and passed unanimously.

- VII. Consultant Planning Services Agreement (PSA): Barton & Loguidice (B&L) is on board for the PSA. Keith Ewald will be managing the project for B&L. Task assignments have been prepared for the Bicycle Pedestrian Connectivity Study, the Public Safety Building New Access Point Study and the City of Watertown Truck Route Study.
- VIII. Host Agreement: The Host Agreement for the MPO needs to be renewed/updated. NYSDOT is the current host. At this point the neither the City nor the County are interested in assuming the role of host for the MPO. A resolution to renew the host agreement will be prepared for the next PC meeting.
- **IX. Transit Update:** Brandi Smith from the Volunteer Transportation Center (VTC) was announced as the new Mobility Manager for the Greater Watertown Urban Area. P. Keenan also mentioned the need to maintain funding to maintain transit assets.
- X. New Business No new business was discussed.
- XI. Local Stakeholders Groups (LSG) Update The last LSG Quarterly update was sent out on January 6th. The River Area Council of Governments (RACOG) has requested that a representative from the MPO participate in one of their Board meetings to discuss the proposed Bicycle/Pedestrian Study.
- XII. Adjournment A motion to adjourn was made by R. Hagemann, it was seconded by K. Mix and passed unanimously.
