Policy Committee (PC) Meeting Summary

- I. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by J. Peck.
- II. Public Comments: None
- **III. Prior Meeting Minutes:** A motion was made by R. Finn to accept the prior (6/4/19) meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by S. Kokkoris and passed unanimously.
- IV. Mobility Management Presentation: A presentation was made by Frank Doldo (Mobility Manager for the St. Lawrence County Public Transit System) and Jennifer Hodge (Development Director for the Volunteer Transportation Center). The presentation explained how mobility management has been successful in St. Lawrence County and how the WJCTC and Jefferson County could benefit from implementing a dedicated mobility manager.
- V. Safety Performance Targets: A motion was made by R. Hagemann to accept Resolution 12-2019 by which the WJCTC agrees to support NYSDOT's 2019 targets for the five Highway Safety Improvement (HSIP) performance measures. It was seconded by J. Butler and passed unanimously. See Appendix A for the full text of Resolution 12-2019.
- VI. TIP Modification: A motion was made by R. Hagemann to accept Resolution 13-2019 which amends the current TIP by adding four two new projects and modifying six others. It was seconded by J. Butler and passed unanimously. See Appendix B for the full text of Resolution 13-2019.

It was also discussed that it would be best not to hold the meeting on a Monday or a Tuesday.
